

CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATION AA DEGREE REQUIREMENTS 2019-2020

• PLAN B is designed primarily for students who intend to transfer to the California State University (CSU). A student may use PLAN B to combine fulfillment of the Associate in Arts general education requirements and the CSU General Education Certification pattern, which is acceptable for the lower division general education requirements for a bachelor's degree at all campuses of the CSU. To complete an A.A. using PLAN B, students must also meet the Health & Wellness Proficiency requirement, specific coursework toward a major, and electives as needed to complete a minimum of 60 degree applicable units with a 2.0 GPA.

PLAN B

- If a student wishes only to transfer and is not seeking an A.A. degree, there are no proficiencies required for CSU General Education (GE) certification. A minimum of 60 CSU transferable units is required for transfer. For other transfer requirement, please see a counselor.
- A maximum of **39 units** of lower division general education may be certified with the units to be distributed as follows: 9 units in Area A; 9 units in Areas B, C, and D, with no more than 30 units in Areas B through D combined; and 3 units in Area E. For students who have completed the course requirements specified, Cerritos College will send official certification of CSU general education completion upon written request through the Admissions and Records office.

• Completion of this pattern is not a requirement for transfer to CSU, nor is it the only way to fulfill the lower division requirements of the CSU. Depending on a student's major field of interest, the student may find it advantageous to take courses fulfilling the general education requirements of the CSU campus to which the student plans to transfer.
